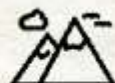

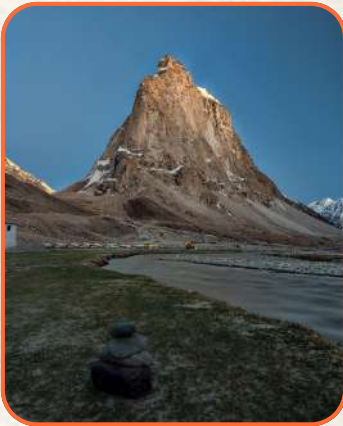

SRINAGAR TO KARGIL VIA SONMARG & ZOJI LA

- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
- Begin an early morning ride towards Sonmarg.
- Cross Zoji La Pass (3,528 m) – one of the most thrilling passes.
- Pay tribute at Drass War Memorial (dedicated to Kargil War heroes).
- Reach Kargil and relax.
- Overnight stay in Kargil.



KARGIL TO LEH VIA LAMAYURU & FOTU LA

- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
- Visit Mulbekh Monastery & witness the Lamayuru Moonland.
- Stop at Magnetic Hill & Sangam Point (Indus-Zaskar Confluence).
- Explore Gurudwara Pathar Sahib & Leh Hall of Fame.
- Reach Leh by evening.
- Overnight stay in Leh.



LEH TO NUBRA VALLEY VIA KHARDUNG LA

- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
- Ride via Khardung La (5,359 m) – one of the highest motorable passes.
- Visit Diskit Monastery (home to a 100-ft Maitreya Buddha statue).
- Enjoy a Double-Humped Camel Ride at Hunder Sand Dunes.
- Explore the scenic Nubra Valley.
- Overnight stay in Nubra.



NUBRA TO TURTUK – BACK TO NUBRA

- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
- Ride to Turtuk Village (the last Indian village near the Pakistan border).
- Experience Balti Culture & Apricot Orchards.
- Visit Turtuk Monastery & Waterfall.
- Return to Nubra by evening.
- Overnight stay in Nubra.



NUBRA TO PANGONG VIA SHYOK ROUTE

- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
- Ride via the Shyok River Route – a thrilling adventure.
- Reach Pangong Lake (4,350 m) – famous for its color-changing waters & Bollywood spots (3 Idiots point).
- Enjoy a peaceful evening by the lake.
- Overnight stay in Pangong (camps).



PANGONG TO LEH VIA CHANG LA

- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
- Start early & ride via Chang La Pass (5,360 m).
- Visit Hemis Monastery & Thiksey Monastery.
- Reach Leh and relax.
- Overnight stay in Leh.



LEH TO SARCHU VIA TANGLANG LA

- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
- Ride via Tanglang La (5,328 m) – one of the highest pass.
- Cross the More Plains – a 40 km straight road at 4,500 m altitude.
- Navigate through Lachung La, Nakee La Pass & the Gata Loops (21 hairpin bends).
- Reach Sarchu, a high-altitude camping site.
- Overnight stay in Sarchu.



SARCHU TO JISPA VIA BARALACHA LA

- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
- Ride via Baralacha La Pass (4,890 m).
- Stop at Suraj Tal & Deepak Tal.
- Reach Jispa, a beautiful valley by the river.
- Overnight stay in Jispa.



JISPA TO MANALI VIA ATAL TUNNEL

- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
- Ride via Keylong & Atal Tunnel.
- Descend towards Manali and check in at the hotel.
- Explore Mall Road, Hidimba Temple, & local cafes.
- Overnight stay in Manali.

Tips for a comfortable Journey

- Drink plenty of water to remain hydrated throughout the trip.
- Trolley bags are not allowed, it is advised to carry only rucksack bags.
- It is advisable to take Diamox as prescribed by your healthcare provider, as abrupt changes in altitude may have detrimental effects on your health.
- Low network connectivity may affect communication during the trip, inform your dear ones at home and in trip mates whenever possible.
- For more details please refer to things to carry.

Important Points

- Be advised that hospitality services may vary significantly due to the remote nature of these areas.
- Rental bikes may have a usage history ranging from 20,000 to 30,000 kilometers, resulting in varying conditions.
- The exact timeline of the itinerary may change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- If a breakdown occurs, a backup and support team will provide assistance.
- Be aware that food taste may vary, especially at high altitudes where cooking can be challenging.
- In remote areas, hot water availability may be limited due to government restrictions on electricity.
- Accommodations may involve split stays due to limited inventory at properties
- Expect delayed response times from hotel/camp staff due to limited personnel.
- Adhere to the trip captain's guidance to successfully complete sightseeing and the journey.
- The trip captain reserves the right to terminate individuals or groups from the trip due to misconduct.
- Standard sizes for riding gear are available, with limited options for plus sizes and small sizes.
- Trip operators and captains may change the itinerary at any time due to weather conditions.

- Be prepared for potential road closures due to snow, landslides, or water overflow; alternative transportation may be used to continue the itinerary.
- A security deposit of ₹8,000 is required per bike at the time of rental, in case of any damages to the bike, the repair costs will be deducted from the security deposit. If the damage costs exceed the deposit amount, the renter will be responsible for paying the additional charges.
- Requests to pre and post checkin/checkout time in Manali or Srinagar are not possible. If you wish to explore the city, you may leave your luggage in the cloakroom or at the reception. However, please note that this is at your own risk.
- Please ensure you are ready at the designated boarding point at the given time. If you miss the bus due to delay on your part, we will not be held responsible, Volvo buses can breakdowns. In such cases, please remain calm. We will arrange a supplementary vehicle as soon as possible to minimize inconvenience.
- Accommodation details will be provided over WhatsApp group created 3-7 days before your departure.
