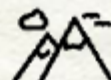

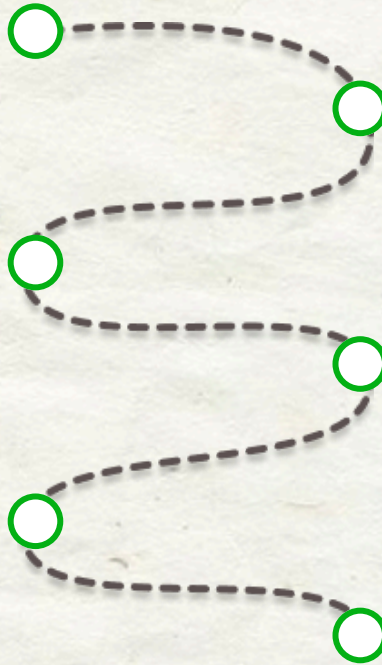

## **GUWAHATI ARRIVAL – TRANSFER TO JOWAI (JAINTIA HILLS)**

- Travel: 160 km | 5-6 hours
- Stay: Jowai (Homestay)
- Arrive at Guwahati Airport/Railway Station and meet your fellow travelers.
- Begin your scenic drive towards Jowai, passing through lush landscapes.
- Visit Thadlaskein Lake, a serene water body with mythological significance.
- Explore the Stone Bridge of Nartiang, a 17th-century monolith site of the Jaintia Kings.
- Evening at leisure – stroll through Jowai town & explore local Khasi cuisine.
- Offbeat Experience: Sunset at Thadlaskein Lake





## **JOWAI TO SHNONGPDENG VIA KREM CHYMPE CAVE**

- Travel: 200 km | 8-9 hours
- Stay: Shnongpdeng (Riverside Camp / Nearby Stay)
- Meals: Breakfast
- Morning Drive to Krem Chympe: One of the longest caves in India, known for its underground river and stunning limestone formations. Enjoy an adventurous cave trek and boating inside the cave (depending on water levels).
- Continue to Shnongpdeng: A hidden paradise on the banks of the Umngot River, famous for its crystal-clear waters.
- Explore the riverside & relax by the Umngot River, soaking in the peaceful surroundings.
- Overnight Stay: If the river flow allows, stay in a riverside camp; otherwise, accommodation will be arranged in a nearby homestay or guesthouse.
- Offbeat Experience: Exploring a lesser-known cave and staying in the heart of nature





## SHNONGPDENG TO CHERRAPUNJI

- Travel: 90 km | 7-8 hours
- Stay: Cherrapunji (Homestay)
- Meals: Breakfast
- Morning at Shnongpdeng: Wake up to the serene views of the Umngot River and enjoy a peaceful morning by the riverside.
- Optional Boating in Umngot River: Experience a mesmerizing boat ride on the crystal-clear waters (subject to river flow and weather conditions).
- Drive to Mawlynnong Village: Visit Asia's cleanest village, walk along the bamboo skywalk, and get stunning views of the Bangladesh plains.
- Visit Mawsahe Waterfall: A hidden waterfall offering a refreshing dip in natural pools.
- Mawsmi Cave Exploration: Walk through the stunning limestone formations of Mawsmi Cave.
- Arrive in Cherrapunji by evening: Check-in at your homestay and unwind in Meghalaya's cool weather.
- Offbeat Experience: Walking on the bamboo skywalk & discovering a hidden root bridge





## **DOUBLE DECKER LIVING ROOT BRIDGE & RAINBOW FALLS TREK**

- Trek: 6-7 hours round-trip
- Stay: Cherrapunji (Homestay)
- Meals: Breakfast
- Begin an early morning trek to the Double Decker Living Root Bridge in Nongriat Village.
- Descend 3,500 steps through dense forests, crossing hanging bridges over blue lagoons & waterfalls.
- Marvel at the 400-year-old natural root bridge, a true engineering marvel.
- Optional: Continue trekking to Rainbow Falls, one of the most breathtaking waterfalls in Meghalaya.
- Return by evening and relax in the chilly weather of Cherrapunji.
- Offbeat Experience: Experience the Living Root Bridge





## **CHERRAPUNJI TO SHILLONG**

### **ARWAH CAVE & SACRED FOREST**

- Travel: 60 km | 7-8 hours
  - Stay: Shillong (Hotel/Homestay)
  - Meals: Breakfast
- 
- Visit Nohkalikai Falls, India's tallest plunge waterfall.
  - Explore Arwah Cave, a massive limestone cave filled with ancient fossils & underground rivers.
  - Explore the Mawphlang Sacred Forest, a mystical ancient Khasi jungle.
  - If time allows, visit Elephant Falls, a three-tiered waterfall near Shillong, perfect for photography.
  - Check-in at your homestay/Hotel and relax.
  - Offbeat Experience: Exploring Meghalaya's sacred tribal forests





## **SHILLONG TO GUWAHATI DROP END OF ADVENTURE**

- Travel: 100 km | 6 hours
- Meals: Breakfast
- Morning visit to Don Bosco Museum, one of North East India's best museums, showcasing the rich culture and heritage of Meghalaya and other northeastern states.
- Drive to Uiam Lake, a scenic reservoir where you can take a short break for photography.
- Drive back to Guwahati.
- Drop-off at Guwahati Airport/Railway Station – Trip Ends with Amazing Memories.
