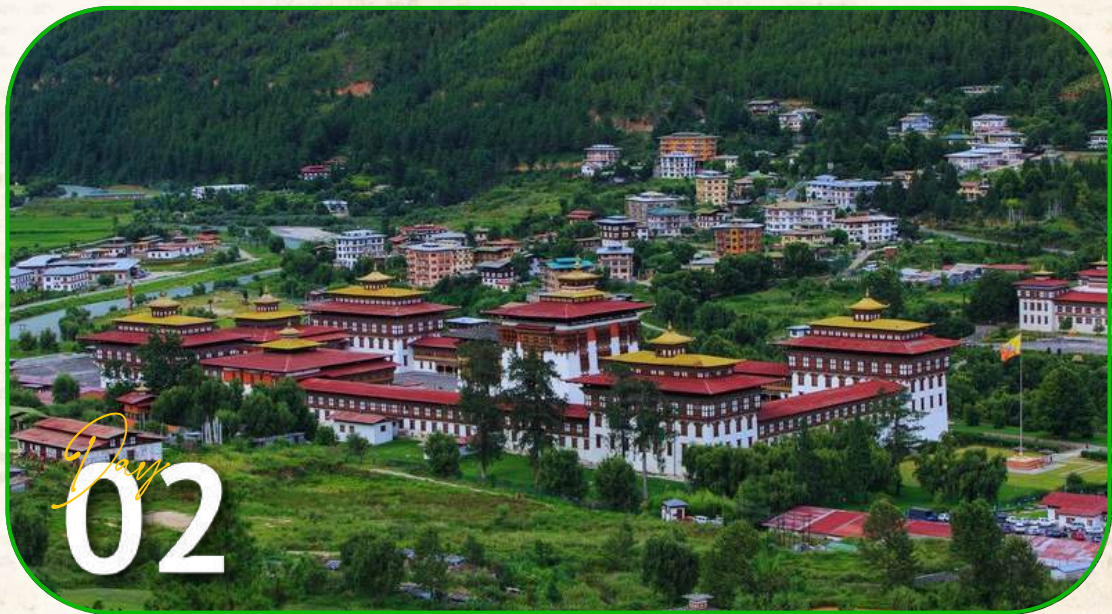


ARRIVAL AT BAGDOGRA – TRANSFER TO PHUENTSHOLING

Meals: Dinner

Drive Time: 4.5 – 5 hours | Distance: ~170 km

- Guests will be greeted at Bagdogra Airport by our tour representative.
- Begin the scenic drive towards Phuentsholing, the Indo-Bhutan border town located at the Himalayan foothills.
- En route, enjoy the changing landscape from lush green plains to gentle hill terrain.
- Upon arrival, check-in at the hotel and complete immigration formalities for Bhutan entry.
- Evening at leisure — explore the local markets or relax after the journey.
- Overnight Stay: Hotel in Phuentsholing



PHUENTSHOLING TO THIMPHU – THE CHARMING CAPITAL

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Drive Time: 3 hours | **Distance:** ~75 km

- After breakfast, begin your journey into Bhutanese highlands.
- Cross the official Bhutan border gate and start the ascent toward Thimphu, Bhutan's capital city.
- En route stops include:
 - Kharbandi Gumpa for panoramic views of the Bengal plains.
 - Waterfalls and scenic valleys like Chukha Dam.
- Arrive in Thimphu and check-in at the hotel.
- Evening free to explore the town, visit cafes, or roam the handicraft market.
- Overnight Stay: Hotel in Thimphu



THIMPHU TO PUNAKHA VIA DOCHULA PASS

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Drive Time: 3 hours | Distance: ~75 km

- Post breakfast, depart for Punakha, the former capital of Bhutan.
- Stop at the iconic Dochula Pass (3,100 m) with 108 memorial stupas and spectacular views of snow-covered Himalayan peaks.
- Descend into the lush Punakha Valley.
- Punakha Dzong – the “Palace of Great Happiness,” Bhutan’s most beautiful fortress at the confluence of Pho Chhu and Mo Chhu rivers.
- Suspension Bridge – one of the longest in Bhutan, offering breathtaking views.
- Evening at leisure to enjoy the peaceful surroundings.
- Overnight Stay: Hotel in Punakha



PUNAKHA TO PHOBJIKHA VALLEY VIA WANGDUE PHODRANG

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Drive Time: 3.5 – 4 hours | Distance: ~80 km

- After breakfast, drive through the scenic countryside to the glacial Phobjikha Valley, home to the endangered Black-Necked Cranes (seasonal: Nov–Feb).
- En route, stop at Wangdue Phodrang for a short break.
- Arrive in Phobjikha and explore:
- Gangtey Monastery – a hilltop 17th-century monastery with sweeping valley views.
- Take a leisurely walk on the Phobjikha Nature Trail, soaking in pristine alpine beauty.
- Relax in the peaceful, remote atmosphere of this high-altitude valley.
- Overnight Stay: Hotel or lodge in Phobjikha.



PHOBJIKHA TO PARO

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Drive Time: 5 – 6 hours | Distance: ~160 km

- After breakfast, embark on the scenic drive to Paro, Bhutan's cultural and spiritual heart.
- Pass through charming villages, winding mountain roads, and picturesque valleys.
- Optional stop at Simtokha Dzong near Thimphu, the oldest fortress in Bhutan.
- On arrival in Paro, check-in and enjoy some free time.
- Explore Paro's traditional Bhutanese architecture and handicraft shops.
- Overnight Stay: Hotel in Paro.



PARO SIGHTSEEING & HIKE TO TIGER'S NEST MONASTERY (TAKTSANG)

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Drive Time: 4 – 5 hours round trip

- Today, after an early breakfast, set off on the iconic hike to Tiger's Nest Monastery, Bhutan's most famous landmark.
- Perched on a cliff 900 meters above Paro Valley, the hike is moderately challenging but immensely rewarding.
- Along the way, stop for tea at the halfway café with views of the monastery.
- Descend after exploring the sacred site.
- Afternoon visits (time permitting):
- Kyichu Lhakhang – one of Bhutan's oldest temples.
- Paro Dzong and Ta Dzong (National Museum).
- Evening to relax and unwind.
- Overnight Stay: Hotel in Paro



PARO TO PHUENTSHOLING VIA SCENIC MOUNTAIN ROADS

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Drive Time: 6 – 7 hours | **Distance:** ~170 km

- After breakfast, begin your return journey from Paro to Phuentsholing.
- Descend through lush forests, valleys, and mountain passes.
- Enjoy a relaxing drive with tea breaks and photo stops along the way.
- On arrival, check-in and rest after the long drive.
- Free time to explore local markets or enjoy your last evening in Bhutan.
- Overnight Stay: Hotel in Phuentsholing.



PHUENTSHOLING TO BAGDOGRA – DEPARTURE

Meals: Breakfast

Drive Time: 4.5 – 5 hours | Distance: ~170 km

- After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive back to Bagdogra Airport.
- Bid farewell to the land of happiness and carry home unforgettable memories.
- The trip ends with a drop-off at Bagdogra for your onward flight.
