












ABOUT THE PLACE




ARRIVAL AT BAGDOGRA – TRANSFER TO PHUENTSHOLING

Drive Time: 5-6 hours

Distance: Approx. 160 km

Meals: Dinner

- Upon arrival at Bagdogra Airport, meet your Bhutanese tour coordinator.
- Begin your journey with a beautiful drive toward Phuentsholing, the southern gateway to Bhutan.
- Drive through lush tea estates of North Bengal, forested terrain, and gentle foothills.
- · Check-in at the hotel and complete immigration formalities.
- Evening at leisure to stroll around the border town and experience Bhutanese hospitality.
- Overnight stay in Phuentsholing



PHUENTSHOLING TO THIMPHU – GATEWAY TO THE HIGHLANDS

Drive Time: 6-7 hours
Distance: Approx. 160 km
Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

- Start the day with a scenic uphill drive into the heart of Bhutan.
- En route, witness beautiful waterfalls, dense forests, and mountain landscapes.
- Stop at picturesque viewpoints and the Rinchending Goemba monastery.
- Arrive in Thimphu, the capital that blends tradition with modernity.
- Enjoy the evening at leisure visit cafés, stroll markets, or explore local streets.
- Overnight stay in Thimphu



THIMPHU TO PHOBJIKHA – THE GLACIAL VALLEY OF CRANES

Drive Time: 5–6 hours Distance: Approx. 130 km Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

- After breakfast, ascend to the breathtaking Dochula Pass (3,100 m) with panoramic views of snow-capped peaks.
- Explore the 108 memorial chortens and take in the tranquil setting.
- Continue toward Phobjikha Valley, one of Bhutan's most serene and untouched regions.
- Visit the Gangtey Monastery, and if visiting in winter, witness the rare black-necked cranes.
- Enjoy a peaceful evening surrounded by meadows and misty hills.
- · Overnight stay in Phobjikha



PHOBJIKHA TO PUNAKHA – RIVERS AND FORTRESSES

Drive Time: 3-4 hours Distance: Approx. 75 km Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

- Depart for Punakha, descending through pine forests and traditional villages.
- En route, stop at Wangdue Phodrang for a glimpse of rural Bhutanese life.
- Upon arrival, visit the majestic Punakha Dzong, situated at the confluence of the Pho and Mo Rivers.
- Cross one of the longest suspension bridges in Bhutan and explore Punakha town.
- · Overnight stay in Punakha



PUNAKHA TO PARO VIA CHELE LA PASS – THE HIGHEST ROAD

Drive Time: 6-7 hours Distance: Approx. 160 km Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

- After breakfast, begin your scenic drive toward Paro, the cultural heart of Bhutan.
- Take a thrilling detour to Chele La Pass (3,988 m) the highest motorable point in Bhutan.
- Soak in 360° views of the Himalayas and snow-dusted peaks like
 Mt. Jomolhari.
- Descend into the Paro Valley, dotted with traditional farmhouses and terraced fields.
- Overnight stay in Paro.



PARO SIGHTSEEING & HIKE TO TIGER'S NEST MONASTERY (TAKTSANG)

Hike Time: 4-5 hours (round trip)

Hike Distance: Approx. 4.5 km one way

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

- Embark on Bhutan's most iconic trek to the sacred Tiger's Nest
 Monastery (Taktsang), built on a 900 m high cliff.
- The hike winds through pine forests, fluttering prayer flags, and mountain springs.
- At the top, enjoy breathtaking views and spiritual energy.
- Return to Paro and visit Kyichu Lhakhang, one of the oldest temples in Bhutan.
- Evening free for shopping and leisure.
- Overnight stay in Paro.



PARO TO PHUENTSHOLING – JOURNEY BACK

Drive Time: 6-7 hours
Distance: Approx. 160 km
Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

- Begin your return drive through familiar yet stunning landscapes.
- Stop at traditional villages or viewpoints along the way.
- Arrive in Phuentsholing, relax, and enjoy your final evening in Bhutan.
- · Overnight stay in Phuentsholing.



PHUENTSHOLING TO BAGDOGRA – DEPARTURE

Drive Time: 5-6 hours

Distance: Approx. 160 km

Meals: Breakfast

• After breakfast, drive back to Bagdogra Airport with beautiful memories of the Land of the Thunder Dragon.
