


Overview

Get ready for the ultimate high-altitude expedition as you journey through the untamed beauty of Ladakh. This 9-night, 10-day bike trip is not just a ride—it's a test of will, thrill, and spirit. Starting from Manali, ride across some of the highest motorable passes in the world, camp beside crystal-clear lakes, and venture deep into the desolate beauty of the Changthang plateau. The crown jewel of the journey is conquering Umling La (19,024 ft)—the highest motorable road on Earth, and witnessing Demchok, India's final village before the Indo-China border. From lunar valleys to off-road river trails, this ride is crafted for thrill-seekers and explorers who live for the extreme.

Whether it's riding through the icy winds of Khardung La, stargazing beside Pangong Tso, or sharing stories with locals in remote Koyul—every turn is a story, every mile is a memory.

OVERNIGHT JOURNEY FROM DELHI TO MANALI

- Your adventure kicks off with a night journey from Delhi.
- Settle in, watch the city lights fade, and let the mountains call.

ARRIVE IN MANALI – ACCLIMATIZATION & GEAR-UP

- Meet your crew, get briefed, and gear up with your motorcycles.
- Roam around Old Manali cafés, sip on Himalayan teas, and get a taste of the mountain vibe.
- Overnight Stay in Manali.




MANALI TO SARCHU – THE FIRST PASSES

- Distance: 225 km | 8–9 hrs
- Ride through the iconic Atal Tunnel, crossing lush valleys into rugged Zaskar terrain.
- Tackle Baralacha La (16,500 ft) – your first taste of high altitude.
- Camp at Sarchu, a windswept plateau surrounded by snow-capped peaks.
- Overnight Stay in Sarchu.



SARCHU TO LEH – A HIGH-ALTITUDE ROLLERCOASTER

- Distance: 250 km | 9–10 hrs
- Cross epic terrain – 21 hairpin Gata Loops, Nakee La, Lachung La, and the vast More Plains.
- Soar over Taglang La (17,480 ft) and descend into the vibrant capital of Leh.
- Overnight Stay in Leh.



LEH TO NUBRA VIA KHARDUNG LA – INTO THE COLD DESERT

- Distance: 160 km | 6–7 hrs
- Conquer Khardung La (18,380 ft) – one of the world’s highest motorable passes.
- Drop into the magical Nubra Valley – home to desert sand dunes and monasteries.
- Explore Diskit Gompa, ride double-humped camels, or simply vibe with the stars.
- Overnight Stay in Nubra Valley.



NUBRA TO PANGONG TSO – RIDING BESIDE THE WILD SHYOK

- Distance: 180 km | 6–7 hrs
- This off-road trail is raw and wild – hugging the mighty Shyok River as it carves through stone.
- Arrive at the surreal Pangong Lake, shimmering with shades of blue under the high-altitude sun.
- Overnight stay at Pangong.



PANGONG TSO TO KOYUL / HANLE

- Distance: 190 km | 7–8 hrs
- Ride through the haunting landscapes of Chushul and the war memorial at Rezang La.
- Reach Koyul / Hanle, a remote Himalayan village surrounded by barren beauty and silence.
- Stay with locals and immerse in the soul of Changthang.
- Overnight Stay at Koyul/ Hanle.




UMLING LA & DEMCHOK DAY RIDE – TOUCH THE SKY

- Distance: 160+ km round trip | 7–8 hrs
- Ride early through wild, unpaved terrain to Umling La (19,024 ft) – the highest motorable road on Earth.
- Continue deeper to Demchok, a high-security village at the very edge of India.
- Return to Koyul by dusk – hearts full, minds blown.
- Overnight Stay at Koyul/ Hanle.



KOYUL/HANLE TO TSO MORIRI VIA PUGA

- Distance: 170 km | 6–7 hrs
- Ride through Nyoma, past boiling mud springs and sulfur clouds of Puga Valley
- Reach the sacred alpine lake of Tso Moriri (15,075 ft) – a haven for Himalayan wildlife.
- Overnight Stay at Tso Moriri.




TSO MORIRI TO SARCHU – THROUGH THE SALT FLATS AND PASSES

- Distance: 220 km | 7–8 hrs
- Ride past Tso Kar, the ghost lake of Ladakh, and rejoin the high passes back toward Sarchu.
- Feel the terrain changing, but the thrill stays the same.
- Overnight Stay at Sarchu.



SARCHU TO MANALI – RETURN RIDE & DEPARTURE TO DELHI

- Distance: 225 km | 8–9 hrs
- Your final ride takes you through Baralacha La one last time.
- Celebrate, refresh, and board your Volvo back to Delhi in the evening.
- Trip Ends, Memories Begin



REACH DELHI

- Arrive Delhi by morning.
- Bid farewell to your fellow travelers and cherish the memories of your incredible Ladakh adventure

Trip Inclusions

- Delhi to Manali & Back Volvo Transfers – Comfortable overnight AC Volvo rides.
- Bike Rental (Day 3 to Day 9) – Get your bike for 7 thrilling days, from Sarchu to Sarchu (only for riders choosing the biking option).

Tips for a comfortable Journey

- Drink plenty of water to remain hydrated throughout the trip.
- Trolley bags are not allowed, it is advised to carry only rucksack bags.
- It is advisable to take Diamox as prescribed by your healthcare provider, as abrupt changes in altitude may have detrimental effects on your health.
- Low network connectivity may affect communication during the trip, inform your dear ones at home and in trip mates whenever possible.
- For more details please refer to things to carry.

Important Points

- Be advised that hospitality services may vary significantly due to the remote nature of these areas.
- Rental bikes may have a usage history ranging from 20,000 to 30,000 kilometers, resulting in varying conditions.
- The exact timeline of the itinerary may change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- If a breakdown occurs, a backup and support team will provide assistance.
- Be aware that food taste may vary, especially at high altitudes where cooking can be challenging.
- In remote areas, hot water availability may be limited due to government restrictions on electricity.
- Accommodations may involve split stays due to limited inventory at properties
- Expect delayed response times from hotel/camp staff due to limited personnel.
- Adhere to the trip captain's guidance to successfully complete sightseeing and the journey.
- The trip captain reserves the right to terminate individuals or groups from the trip due to misconduct.
- Standard sizes for riding gear are available, with limited options for plus sizes and small sizes.
- Trip operators and captains may change the itinerary at any time due to weather conditions.

- Be prepared for potential road closures due to snow, landslides, or water overflow; alternative transportation may be used to continue the itinerary.
- Due to limited inventory in Hanle, accommodations can be provided on a triple and quad sharing basis.
- A security deposit of ₹8,000 is required per bike at the time of rental, in case of any damages to the bike, the repair costs will be deducted from the security deposit. If the damage costs exceed the deposit amount, the renter will be responsible for paying the additional charges.
- Requests to pre and post checkin/checkout time in Leh or Srinagar are not possible. If you wish to explore the city, you may leave your luggage in the cloakroom or at the reception. However, please note that this is at your own risk.
- Please ensure you are ready at the designated boarding point at the given time. If you miss the bus due to delay on your part, we will not be held responsible, Volvo buses can breakdowns. In such cases, please remain calm. We will arrange a supplementary vehicle as soon as possible to minimize inconvenience.
- Accommodation details will be provided over WhatsApp group created 3-7 days before your departure.
