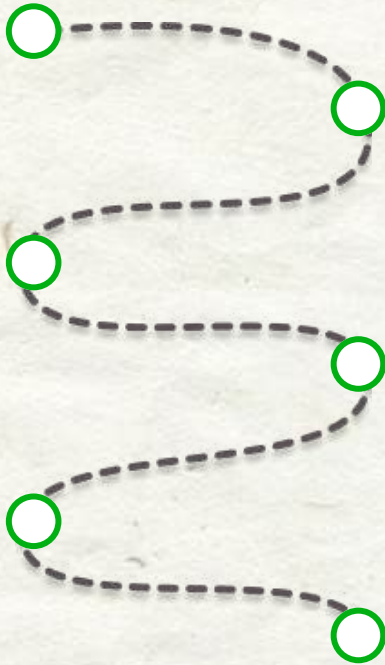

GUWAHATI – SHILLONG

- Arrival at Guwahati Airport / Railway Station and transfer to Shillong.
- Visit Umiyam Lake (Barapani) – scenic reservoir surrounded by hills.
- Explore Lady Hydari Park – landscaped garden with flower beds and mini zoo.
- Visit Police Bazaar – main market for shopping and local experiences.
- Visit Air Force Museum – showcases the Indian Air Force's history in the Northeast.
- Check-in at hotel.
- Overnight stay at Shillong.



SHILLONG – DAWKI / SHNONGPDENG

- Depart for Dawki / Shnongpdeng.
- Visit Laitlum Canyons – breathtaking valley views.
- Explore Krang Suri Falls – crystal-clear waterfall with natural pools.
- Visit Phi Phi Falls – multi-tiered waterfall surrounded by lush greenery.
- Walk across Shnongpdeng Hanging Bridge over the Umngot River. Check-in at Shnongpdeng.

Overnight stay at Shnongpdeng:

Accommodation will be in Alpine/Dome tents with shared washrooms. The camps are set amidst a rocky landscape, offering a basic setup with mattresses or sleeping bags provided. Located near the river, access may involve a slightly uneven path. Guests should be prepared for a simple yet adventurous experience close to nature.

SHILLONG TO DAWKI CAMPING

- Enjoy Dawki Water Activities – Boating, Kayaking, Snorkeling, and Cliff Jumping (subject to water level and safety conditions).
- Visit Mawlynnong Village – Asia’s cleanest village with living root bridges and the Balancing Rock.
- Explore Wei Sawdong Waterfall – scenic three-tiered waterfall.
- Transfer to Cherrapunjee.
- Check-in at hotel.
- Overnight stay at Cherrapunjee.

CHERRAPUNJEE | LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

- Trek to the Double Decker Living Root Bridge – a unique natural bridge formed by rubber tree roots.
- Visit Rainbow Falls – cascading waterfall near the root bridge area.
- Explore Blue Lagoon – a serene natural pool for relaxation.
- Return to hotel.
- Overnight stay at Cherrapunjee.

CHERRAPUNJEE – SHILLONG

- Transfer to Shillong.
- Visit Nohkalikai Falls – one of India's tallest waterfalls.
- Explore Seven Sisters Falls – a series of seven cascading waterfalls.
- Visit Garden of Caves – natural cave formations and small waterfalls.
- Stop at Mawkdok Dympep Valley View Point – panoramic valley views.
- Visit Lyngksiar Falls – scenic waterfall.
- Visit Elephant Falls – three-tier waterfall near Shillong.
- Check-in at hotel.
- Overnight stay at Shillong.



SHILLONG – GUWAHATI (DEPARTURE)

- Visit Mawphlang Sacred Forest – ancient forest with rich biodiversity and cultural significance.
- Stop at Ward’s Lake – artificial lake with boating and walking paths.
- Transfer to Guwahati Airport / Railway Station for onward journey.

- Travelers from outside Guwahati are advised to book flights or trains arriving no later than 12:00 PM on the first day. For the return journey, schedule flights or trains departing after 6:00 PM on the last day.
